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政府一直以「多管齊下」的禁毒策略,與社會各界合作,打擊毒害。當中,戒毒治療和康復服務更是不可或缺的一環。香港戒毒會多年來為吸毒人士提供戒毒治療和康復服務,是最具經驗和規模的戒毒服務機構之一,並一直是政府在抗毒工作上的重要伙伴。

吸毒形勢瞬息萬變,禁毒工作亦要因時制宜。戒毒服務機構須因應毒品形勢積極提供切合戒毒人士實際需要的服務,幫助他們重獲新生,並且此後持守遠離毒品。就此,香港戒毒會除了提供自願住院式戒毒治療和康復服務,以及為參與美沙酮治療計劃的人士提供跟進輔導服務外,亦在禁毒基金的支持下,積極推展其他服務計劃,例如提供職業技能培訓和就業配對、舉辦各式各樣的興趣小組課程以協助戒毒人士建立健康正面的嗜好、為吸毒者家人提供輔導和支援等。香港戒毒會亦提供支援多元種族人士的戒毒服務,以及進行外展推展禁毒預防教育及宣傳工作。

在過去六十餘年,香港戒毒會支持無數吸毒人士決心戒除毒癮,展開無毒新生活。我衷心感謝香港戒毒會各委員和同工一直以來對抗毒工作的貢獻,以及以熱誠和專業的態度支援吸毒人士、戒毒康復者及他們的家人,造福多個家庭。

謹此祝願香港戒毒會工作順利,繼續幫助更多有需要的人脫離毒海,重過健康美好人生。

We work hand in hand with different sectors of the community in the fight against drugs. Amongst all, treatment and rehabilitation (T&R) is an indispensable component. The Society for the Aid and Rehabilitation of Drug Abusers (SARDA) has been continuously providing T&R services to cater for the needs of drug abusers for years. As one of the most experienced and largest T&R service agencies in Hong Kong, SARDA is a key partner of the Government in taking forward our anti-drug efforts.

Anti-drug works should be agile and flexible amid the evolving drug scene. In this regard, in addition to its voluntary residential drug treatment and rehabilitation programmes as well as follow-up counselling services for participants of the out-patient methadone treatment programme, SARDA has initiated many other service projects with the support of the Beat Drugs Fund. Examples include vocational training programmes and job matching services, interest classes that help drug rehabilitees develop healthy and positive hobbies, counselling and support services to family members of drug abusers, etc. Besides, SARDA provides T&R services to people of diverse race and takes forward anti-drug preventive education and publicity through outreaching.

In over 60 years, SARDA has helped countless drug abusers quit drugs and lead a new drug-free life. I would like to express my heartfelt appreciation to the Committee Members and staff of SARDA for their contributions to the anti drug cause, dedicated services and enthusiasm in aiding drug abusers, drug rehabilitees and their families.

Our best wishes to SARDA for their continuous success in helping more needy ones to recover from drug abuse and re-build a healthy and fruitful life.

The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region



香港戒毒會成立於1961年,為全港最大型的志願戒 毒機構,以「有戒無類」精神,免費為不同年齡、 性別、種族和宗教的濫藥人士提供戒毒治療及康復 服務,協助有志戒除毒癮的濫藥人士建立健康新生 活,並為其家人提供多元化服務。本會亦積極與政 府及各界持份者攜手推動禁毒預防教育,締造關愛 共融社會。

本會轄下設有四間住院式戒毒治療及康復中心、四間社會服務中心及五間中途宿舍,提供戒毒治療、善後輔導及支援重投社會等服務。去年,入住本會轄下四間戒毒治療康復中心人數共715人,斷癮程序完成率是85%,康復程序完成率為87%,而善後輔導完成率達94%。此外,本會在衞生署轄下全港美沙酮診所,為美沙酮服藥人士及其家人提供個人及小組輔導服務。

本會於年度內全力應對新型冠狀病毒病的挑戰·因應疫情跌宕起伏的演變·總幹事譚紫樺續領導七個專責小組·包括:「人力資源應變」、「防疫物資」、「運作模式上應變」、「跨部門入院應變管理」、「抗疫衞生準備及預防教育」、「COVID-19創傷復原暨精神健康」及「善用資訊科技」,在保障同事及服務對象健康的大前題下·本會於提供服務上作出適當應變·加上同事們通力合作·總算可以順利提供服務。

迎接挑戰

根據藥物濫用資料中央檔案室(CRDA) 2023年首季數字與2022年同期比較,所有被呈報的吸毒人數上升18%,其中首次被呈報的吸毒人數更上升45%,而被呈報的非華裔吸毒人數亦同樣上升45%。另外,21歲以下青少年最常吸食的毒品依次為可卡因、大麻及氯胺酮,其中吸食可卡因者超過一半。而因干犯毒品罪行而被捕的人士當中,牽涉可卡因的為數亦是最多。隨著社會全面復常,社交及娛樂聚會漸趨頻繁,加上部份海外地區放寬對毒品的政策,尤其將大麻推廣為減壓、時尚的產品,削弱一般人對毒品的戒心,相信會為香港的吸毒情況迎來新挑戰。

The Society for the Aid and Rehabilitation of Drug Abusers (SARDA) was established in 1961 and is the largest voluntary drug treatment and rehabilitation organisation in Hong Kong. With the spirit of "No Drug Addict Left Behind", SARDA provides free drug treatment and rehabilitation services to drug abusers of different ages, genders, races and religions, helping those who want to quit drug addiction to build a healthy new life, and provides diversified services for their families. SARDA also actively works with the Government and stakeholders of different sectors to promote drug prevention education for creating a caring and inclusive society.

SARDA operates four residential drug treatment and rehabilitation centres, four social service centres and five halfway houses that provide drug treatment, aftercare counselling and support drug rehabilitants to reintegrate into the society. Last year, a total of 715 people were admitted to the four drug treatment and rehabilitation centres. The detoxification rate was 85%, rehabilitation rate was 87%, and the aftercare completion rate was 94%. In addition, SARDA provides individual and group counselling services for methadone patients and their families at all methadone clinics under the Department of Health.

During the reporting year, SARDA made every effort to respond to the challenge triggered by the novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19). In response to the rapid development of the epidemic, Executive Director Ms. Angelique TAM continued to lead seven task forces, including: "Human Resources Preparedness and Response", "Disease Prevention Material Supplies", "Mode of Operation Preparedness and Response", "Inter-departmental Admission Response Management", "Disease Prevention Preparedness and Preventive Education", "COVID-19 Post-traumatic Recovery cum Mental Health", and "Strategic Development of Information Technology". With the ultimate objective of protecting the health of colleagues and service recipients, SARDA has made appropriate changes in service provision. Together with the full cooperation of colleagues, we can finally provide services smoothly.

Taking Up Challenges

Based on the information from the Central Registry of Drug Abuse (CRDA), the figure of the first quarter of 2023 as compared with the same period in 2022 reveals that the number of all reported drug abusers increased by 18%, of which the number of newly reported drug abusers rose by 45%. The number of reported non-ethnic Chinese drug abusers also increased by 45%. In addition, the most commonly used drugs among teenagers under the age of 21 are cocaine, cannabis and ketamine, with more than half of them using cocaine. Among the people arrested for drug offenses, most of them were involved in cocaine. As the society returns to normalcy, social and entertainment gatherings become more frequent, and some overseas regions relax their drug policies. In particular, cannabis is promoted as a stress-relieving and fashionable product, which weakens the general public's wariness of drugs, hence posting new challenges to Hong Kong's effort in anti-drug abuses and education.

針對吸毒情況的挑戰 · 尤其是接觸受毒品問題影響的青少年及年輕成年吸毒者 · 本會凹頭青少年中心及區貴雅修女紀念婦女康復中心積極透過社交媒體廣泛接觸青少年 · 以貼近年輕文化的手法及內容宣傳中心服務 · 亦廣泛地接觸和聯繫受毒品問題影響的年輕人 · 包括隱蔽吸毒者 · 吸引他們的注意 · 從而正視自身吸毒問題 · 尋求戒毒治療和康復服務。

為加強向青少年推廣禁毒預防訊息·本會凹頭青少年中心為天主教崇德英文書院及旅港開平商會中學分別舉辦線上及實體禁毒預防教育講座·宣揚抗毒信息·讓學生認識青少年住院式戒毒治療及康復服務·合共逾400位中學生參加。講座透過遊戲讓學生體會朋輩壓力對個人選擇的影響·啟發面對毒品誘惑時應作出拒絕。此外,講座亦帶出吸食毒品的禍害·特別是大麻、可卡因、氯胺酮、冰毒等,對個人身心健康及成長的影響。凹頭青少年中心學員亦於講座上真誠分享作為「過來人」的成功戒毒康復經驗。

此外,香港警務處毒品調查科禁毒領袖學院亦與本會石鼓洲康復院合辦禁毒預防教育及義工服務,由毒品調查科總警司吳頴詩率領來自20間中學及8間大學,共120名禁毒領袖學院之師生到訪石鼓洲進行各項活動,更安排「過來人」分享成功戒毒康復經驗,讓參加者能深入認識毒品對自身、家人及各方面的嚴重影響,以推廣抗毒信息。而石鼓洲康復院亦於年度內到長洲官立中學為100位中學生舉辦禁毒預防教育講座,傳遞「要向毒品說不」的信息。

承傳創新

本會多年來一直關注非華裔社群的需要,年度內成功向禁毒基金申請撥款,推行「非華裔人士社區外展導航服務計劃(全港性)」,旨在針對本地非華裔人士 的特徵與需要,提供禁毒預防教育及宣傳,並盡早計別高危、隱蔽的吸毒者,以提供動機式面談、危機引入、情緒支援及戒毒治療轉介等服務,並為受毒品問題困擾的家庭提供支援,提升其家庭功能。此外,制題困擾的家庭提供支援,提升其家庭功能。此外,制劃亦會建立跨界別合作網絡,連結地區團體及領袖、宗教團體及社福機構等不同社區持分者,建立持續性伙伴合作關係,共同服務社區內有需要的人士。

為多方面照顧非華裔社群的獨特需要,加強社會及家庭的支援,本會在投資者及理財教育委員會(投委會)贊助下,推行「『錢』途『理』智醒NEC」計劃。透過提供一系列的理財教育小組、名人分享工作坊及各項體驗式學習活動,期望協助非華裔人士培養理財習慣,為自己的未來作計劃,並支援他們於新冠疫情期間及往後的日子增強財務抗逆能力,以推廣共融理財教育及鼓勵他們建立良好的理財行為。

In terms of drug history, the median drug history of newly reported abusers in 2022 has risen from 3.4 years in 2021 to 4.2 years. The median drug history among newly reported drug abusers aged under 21 increased from 1.2 years in 2021 to 1.5 years in 2022. As for the most common drug taking place, including all reported drug users under the age of 21, the choice is still "home/friend's home", which shows that hidden drug use still requires close attention.

To address the challenges of drug abuse, especially to get in touch with youth and young adult drug abusers, our Au Tau Youth Centre (ATYC) and Sister Aquinas Memorial Women's Treatment Centre (WTC) reach out to young people actively and extensively through social media, using methods and content close to the youth culture so as to promote the Centres' services. The Centres also widely contact young people affected by drug problems, including hidden drug abusers, to attract their attention and help them face their own drug problems, thereby seeking drug treatment and rehabilitation services.

In order to strengthen the promotion of drug prevention messages to young people, ATYC organised online and physical anti-drug activities for Shung Tak Catholic English College and Hoi Ping Chamber of Commerce Secondary School. Anti-drug preventive education talks were held to promote anti-drug information and let students know about youth residential drug treatment and rehabilitation services. Over 400 secondary school students participated. During the talks, games were organised to help students understand the impact of peer pressure on personal choices, and inspire students to refuse drug temptations. In addition, the talks also highlighted the dangers of drug use, especially the impact of cannabis, cocaine, ketamine, and methamphetamine on physical and mental health, and on personal growth. The rehabilitants from ATYC also shared their successful drug rehabilitation experiences as ex-drug abusers.

In addition, the Leadership Institute on Narcotics (L.I.O.N.) of the Hong Kong Police's Narcotics Bureau and the Shek Kwu Chau Treatment and Rehabilitation Centre (SKC) jointly organised anti-drug preventive education and volunteer services. Chief Superintendent of Narcotics Bureau Ms. NG Wing-sze led a total of 120 teachers and students of the L.I.O.N., coming from 20 secondary schools and 8 universities, to visit SKC to carry out various activities. SKC also arranged for ex-drug abusers to share their successful drug rehabilitation experiences, helping participants to better understand the serious impact of drugs on an individual, family and all other aspects, thereby promoting anti-drug messages. SKC also held anti-drug prevention education talks for 100 secondary school students at the Cheung Chau Government Secondary School during the reporting year to convey the message of "Say NO to Drugs".

Heritage and Innovation

SARDA has been paying close attention to the needs of the non-ethnic Chinese community for many years. During the reporting year, we successfully applied for funding from the Beat Drugs Fund to implement the "Project CONNECT - Community Outreach Navigation for Non-Ethnic Chinese (Territory-wide)", which aims to provide drug prevention education and publicity based on the characteristics and needs of non-ethnic Chinese people in Hong Kong. The project helps to identify high-risk and hidden drug users as early as possible, thereby providing for them motivational interview, crisis intervention, emotional support and drug treatments. It also provides support to families troubled by drug problems and improves their family functions. In addition, the project will also establish a cross-sector cooperation network to connect different community stakeholders, such as local groups and leaders, religious groups and social welfare organisations to establish sustained partnerships, so as to jointly serve those in need in the community.

In order to take care of the unique needs of the non-ethnic Chinese community and to strengthen social and family support, SARDA, with the sponsorship from the Investor and Financial Education Council (IFEC), launched the "Investor and Financial Education Programme for Vulnerable Groups". By providing a series of financial education groups, celebrity sharing workshops and various experiential learning activities, we hope to help nonethnic Chinese people develop financial management habits, and to plan for their future. The Programme also supported them to enhance financial resilience during and after the COVID-19 epidemic, and promoted inclusive financial management education and encouraged them to establish good financial management behaviours.

此外·本會繼續關注受濫藥問題影響的家庭的需要·年度內向禁毒基金申請撥款·成功獲得資助以延續推行為期18個月的「健康家庭親子樂計劃3.0」。計劃會強化現有服務及擴大服務範圍、透過評估、親職技能訓練及家庭活動等·提升相關家長及戒毒康復家長的親職能力·並提升相關家長及戒毒能力及信心。計劃透過組織康復家長等。計劃亦會提供專業訓練·提升社工在協助吸毒人士子女的自我效能感。

另就員工發展方面,為可更有效地按照實際的運作需要而進行員工表現評核及發展之工作,本會於年度內開始實行全新的表現評核制度,以更有效檢視員工工作目標的執行進度、工作表現及能力。此外,年度內本會亦開展提升現有人力資源管理系統工程,將系統進行全面電子化並升級至雲端工作平台,以加強員工自助服務,減輕日常作業負擔。

伙伴攜手

本會致力與不同持份者建立及保持緊密合作關係,發展為長遠的合作伙伴,攜手推動戒毒康復服務,使戒毒康復人士獲得社會上不同界別人士的支持和接納,促進社會共融。

年度內本會續獲香港賽馬會慈善信託基金及香港公 益金支持,推行「同輩輔導及見習學員計劃。計劃主要為聘用成功分分 復員為同輩輔導,作為角色模範,並藉著分別 康復經驗啟發、提升其他康復員的改變動機; 調練協助學員培養工作習內質 計劃來協助學員培養工作習慣,學習應對工作此外 報,為重返社會作準備,減低復吸機會。 及「見習學員」,透過的 報 ,為重返社會作準備,減低復吸機會。 港賽馬會慈善信託基金更資助「同輩輔導」及「見會 ,接受培訓,提升其就業能力,增加受聘機會, 有助重投社會。

本會美沙酮輔導服務於年度內續與惠氏營養品香港 合作 · 舉行「惠氏營養品伴你美麗人生講座」之 「康復人士之營養需要」 · 講座以線上形式進行 · 與戒毒康復人士及其家人分享實用的健康知識 · 包 括康復人士營養不足的原因、藥物對身體營養的影 響、情緒與身體健康的關係及推薦康復人士之飲食 習慣。參加者亦在營養師的指導下 · 即時設計營養 餐單 · 發揮活學活用精神。 In addition, SARDA continues to pay attention to the needs of families affected by drug problems. During the reporting year, we applied for funding from the Beat Drugs Fund and successfully received funding to continue the 18-month "Happy and Healthy Family Scheme 3.0". The Scheme strengthened the existing services and expanded the scope of services. Through assessment, parenting skills training and family activities, the Scheme enhanced the parenting capabilities of drug using parents and parents who have recovered from drug addiction, and improved their anti-drug ability and confidence. The Scheme also organised a team of rehabilitated parent volunteers to disseminate anti-drug messages to young people, thereby helping them to help themselves. Besides, the Scheme boosted the self-efficacy of social workers in assisting children of drug abusers by providing them with professional training.

In terms of employee development, in order to conduct employee performance evaluation and development more effectively based on actual operational needs, SARDA implemented the new "Enhanced Performance Management System" in the reporting year to more effectively monitor employees' implementation progress, abilities and work performance against their work goals. In addition, during the year, we upgraded the existing human resources management system, making it fully digitised and a cloud-based work platform so as to enhance employee self-help services and reduce their burden during daily operations.

Partnership

SARDA is committed to establishing and maintaining close cooperative relationships with different stakeholders, developing into long-term partners, and working together to promote drug rehabilitation services. This way, drug rehabilitants would be accepted by and gain support from different sectors of the society, fostering social inclusion.

During the reporting year, SARDA continued to receive support from The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust and The Community Chest of Hong Kong to implement the "Peer Counsellor and Internship Scheme" and the "Peer Counselling Scheme". Under these Schemes, drug rehabilitants are employed as peer counsellors, who act as role models to inspire other rehabilitants by sharing their successful rehabilitation experience, strengthening rehabilitants' motivation to change for good. These Schemes also provide opportunities for suitable rehabilitants to become "interns", who would receive vocational training to learn how to cope with challenges at work, be prepared for reintegration into the society, and reduce the chance of relapse. The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust also supports peer counsellors and interns for vocational training, which enhances their employability and consolidates the foundation for them to reintegrate into the society.

Concerned about the high risk of HIV infection among drug abusers and to reduce their chances of being harmed by the virus, we continue to implement the "A Holistic Approach on HIV/AIDS Prevention, Care and Support Programme for Drug Users, SARDA" through a sponsorship from the AIDS Trust Fund. The Programme includes the "Phoenix Project" and the "Spark Action". The "Phoenix Project" recruits a group of drug rehabilitants and Nepalese methadone patients to provide HIV/AIDS preventive education for street-loitering drug abusers through an outreaching approach, so as to increase risk awareness among them. The "Spark Action" provides health and psychosocial education counselling services for people living with HIV, in order to enhance their motivation to receive AIDS and drug rehabilitation treatments.

The Methadone Treatment Programme Counselling Service continued to cooperate with Wyeth Nutrition Hong Kong during the reporting year to organise the "Wyeth Nutrition Supports Your Beautiful Life Lecture". The lecture "Nutrition for Rehabilitants" was held online to share practical health knowledge with drug rehabilitants and their families, including the causes of nutritional deficiencies among rehabilitants, the impact of drugs on nutrition in our body, the relationship between emotions and physical health, and recommended dietary habit for rehabilitants. Participants also designed nutritious meal menu under the guidance of nutritionists, applying what they have learned into practice.

就特別提升年輕女性戒毒學員重返社會的信心及投入 職場的競爭力。區貴雅修女紀念婦女康復中心於年度 內與不同團體、機構合作。舉辦多項導師認證證書課程,包括「旋風球基礎證書課程」、「三葉球導師認 證課程」、「躲避盤指導員證書課程」、「寵物美容 師課程」、「基礎地板冰壺教練培訓班」及「日本酒 精墨水藝術證書課程」、學員合共考獲38張導師認 證證書。

年度內成年婦女康復中心繼續與基督教聯合醫院合作, 舉行「流動認知功能康復計劃 2.0」,為康復中的學員 提供服務前評估及復原計劃,並進行認知功能訓練。

社區協作

本會積極與社區多方協作・推廣宣傳禁毒信息・與社區 人士攜手抗毒。本會與國際獅子總會中國港澳303區青 年拓展及禁毒警覺委員會 (YODAC) 持續合作推行禁毒 警覺活動・於年度內舉行「中秋關懷行動」、「濃情暖 意賀新春」、「YODAC愛心滿載石鼓洲」及「YODAC 獎勵計劃」,積極推動社區人士關懷及接納戒毒康復人 士,並關注他們的下一代成長,又向社會不同持分者提 供抗毒資訊,共建無毒社會。

年度內本會亦有參加「滙豐香港社區節2022」. 由美沙酮治療計劃輔導服務功課輔導班學員及導師 合作進行音樂表演,並再度夥拍佛香講堂羅陳楚思 長者鄰舍中心合作演出,長幼攜手宣揚健康生活、 遠離毒品的信息。

積極倡導

本會重視宣傳戒毒治療及康復工作,一方面加強社會人士認識毒害,另一方面亦推動社會人士在重返人士(「過來人」),讓他們在重返社會過程中得到接納和社會認同。年度內本企與幹會調案權、社會福利總監、成年婦女康復功中心。 學員、美沙酮治療計劃輔導服務的成功戒毒原復分世與家人等,亦分別接受《文匯報》、《訪問的人士與家人等之種報》、《星島日報》等計劃的大眾推廣本會服務,分享成功戒毒康復入士及早時發經驗,呼籲受毒品問題困擾人士及早時求專業協助。

培育人才

In order to enhance the confidence of young female drug abusers in reintegrating into the society and their competitiveness in entering the workplace, WTC cooperated with different groups and organisations during the reporting year to organise a number of instructor certification courses, including the "Flyball Foundation Certification Course", "Flipball Instructor Certification Course", "Dodgebee Instructor Certification Course", "Professional Canine Cosmetologist", "Fundamental Floor Curling Coach Training", and "Alcohol Ink Art plus one Instructor Training". Rehabilitants obtained a total of 38 instructor certificates.

During the year, the Adult Female Rehabilitation Centre (AFRC) continued to cooperate with United Christian Hospital to conduct the "Mobile Functional Cognition Programme 2.0", which provides pre-service assessment, recovery planning, and functional cognitive training for recovering trainees.

Community Collaboration

SARDA actively collaborates with various parties in the community to promote anti-drug information and join hands with community members to fight against drugs. We continued to cooperate with the Youth Outreach & Drug Awareness Committee (YODAC) of Lions Clubs International District 303 - Hong Kong & Macao, China to implement anti-drug awareness activities, including "Mid-Autumn Caring Action", "Warm Hearts to Celebrate the New Year", "YODAC Love in Shek Kwu Chau" and "YODAC Award Scheme". These activities actively promoted community members to care for and accept drug rehabilitants, and pay attention to the growth of their next generation. They also provided anti-drug information to different stakeholders in order to build a drug-free society.

During the reporting year, SARDA also participated in the HSBC Hong Kong Community Festival 2022, where the trainees and tutors of the Methadone Treatment Programme Counselling Service Homework Tutorial Class orchestrated a music performance. They once again partnered with the International Buddhist Progress Society Law Chan Chor Sze Neighbourhood Elderly Centre to perform; seniors and juniors joined hands to promote healthy living and drug-free messages.

Active Advocate

SARDA attaches great importance to the publicity of drug treatment and rehabilitation work. On the one hand, we enhance the public's understanding of drug abuse, and on the other hand, we promote to members of the society the positive image of drug rehabilitants in the capacity of "an exdrug abusers", so that they can be accepted and recognised by the public in the process of reintegrating into the society. During the reporting year, Executive Director, Ms. Angelique TAM, Superintendent of Social Service, Superintendent and trainee of AFRC, rehabilitant and family members of Methadone Treatment Programme Counselling Services had accepted interviews from "Wen Wei Po", "Ta Kung Pao", "Hong Kong Economic Times", and "Sing Tao Daily" to share with the public SARDA's services, and the challenging journey and transformation experience of successful drug rehabilitants, and appeal to people suffering from drug problems to seek professional assistance as soon as possible.

Nurturing Talents

SARDA has always been actively engaged in various exchanges and cooperation with colleagues in the drug rehabilitation field. During the reporting year, Executive Director Ms. Angelique TAM and colleagues participated in the "Sharing session of training workshops on the spirit of the 20th National Congress of CPC for local social welfare sector", which was jointly organised by the Labour and Welfare Bureau, the Department of Social Affairs of the Liaison Office of the Central People's Government in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, the Social Welfare Department, and the Hong Kong Social Welfare Sector Joint Action Against COVID-19. Besides, Ms. TAM was invited by Solomon Learning, co-founded by the former Hong Kong Financial Secretary Mr. Anthony LEUNG and the former Chairman of the Harvard Business School Association, to serve as a mentor in Project M² (Project Morals & Money) summer leadership programme, which assists students to have a correct and basic concept of money from an early age, learn Financial Quotient (FQ), and develop correct values.

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

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



- 1 The Society for the Aid and Rehabilitation of Drug Abusers (SARDA) was established in 1961 with the following aims:
 - To give aid to, to treat and to take all necessary steps to rehabilitate persons who are drug abusers,
 - To promote public education against drug abuse,
 - iii) To consult, advise, or co-operate with any other person or organisation in furthering the aims of the Society,
 - iv) To make such recommendations to the Government and to advocate such laws as may be deemed necessary in furthering these aims.
- 2) To take any other action deemed necessary for the furtherance of the aims of the Society, including, without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing:
 - building, equipping and managing any property or institution wherein persons are to be housed for treatment and rehabilitation,

- None of the aims of the Society includes the acquisition of gain by the Society or its individual members. The Society is subvented on a deficiency grant basis by the Government for the treatment and rehabilitation of drug abusers on a voluntary basis. It is a member of the Hong Kong Council of Social Service and a founding member agency of The Community Chest of Hong Kong.

香港戒毒會是全港最大型的志願戒毒機構,以醫 療及社會心理輔導模式,免費為自願人士提供多 元化的戒毒治療及康復服務。本會轄下有四間住 院式戒毒治療及康復中心、包括兩間男性中心及 兩間女性中心。其中,石鼓洲康復院及凹頭青少 年中心是為男性而設;區貴雅修女紀念婦女康復 中心及成年婦女康復中心是為女性而設。門診式 的戒毒治療服務則有美沙酮治療計劃輔導服務。

The Society for the Aid and Rehabilitation of Drug Abusers (SARDA) is the largest voluntary drug rehabilitation organisation in Hong Kong. It adopts medical and psycho-social counselling model and provides diversified voluntary treatment and rehabilitation services, free of charge to drug abusers. There are four residential drug treatment and rehabilitation centres including two for males and two for females. Shek Kwu Chau Treatment and Rehabilitation Centre and Au Tau Youth Centre are for males. Sister Aquinas Memorial Women's Treatment Centre and Adult Female Rehabilitation Centre are for females. Under the methadone treatment counselling programme, we provide counselling service in out-patient methadone clinics.

In addition, SARDA runs four social service centres and five halfway houses which provide aftercare and other support services. There is also a clinic. SARDA responds proactively to the changing service demands and actively collaborates with Government departments and various sectors to promote anti-drug community education.

石鼓洲康復院於1963年4月成立,為不同年齡吸食海 洛英毒品的男士提供免費及自願的治療和康復服務。 又於2010年8月開始推行「新德計劃」,為18歲或以 上吸食危害精神毒品的男士提供綜合住院康復療程。 現時院內設有260個宿位,是全港最大型的自願戒毒 中心之一。海洛英毒品濫用者的治療程序包括一至三 星期的斷癮治療,以及隨後12至26星期的個人康復療 程。至於危害精神毒品濫用者,一般療程為期26至 52星期。所有院友需每月接受評估,以審視其治療進 度及為他們未來重新融入社區作好準備。去年,本院 共收納592名人士入院。

院方提供全面的社交心理技巧訓練予院友,以至教育 預防重吸毒品和預防感染愛滋病等。為增強院友的就 業能力,院方去年籌辦了多項職業訓練課程,包括由 禁毒基金撥款的油漆裝飾班和水管裝嵌班,由僱員再 培訓局資助的廚務助理基礎證書課程,以及由勞工及 福利局成人教育資助計劃下的基礎電腦班,院友完成 課程後會獲取相關機構簽發的證書。除此以外,院方 提供多項工作治療,包括木工、金工、泥水、魚菜共 生耕作、園藝、美術,以至內部維修保養等。院方更 特別為非華裔院友提供多項課程,包括中文班、音樂 班、魔術班以及咖啡沖調課程,以協助他們投入本地 汁區。

Shek Kwu Chau Treatment and Rehabilitation Centre (SKC) has come into operation since April 1963, providing free and voluntary treatment and rehabilitation services to male heroin abusers of different age groups. In August 2010, "Project SARDA" was launched to provide a comprehensive residential treatment programme for male psychotropic substance abusers aged 18 or above. With the accommodation capacity of 260, SKC is the largest of the same kind in Hong Kong. For heroin abusers, the treatment programme involves a 1 to 3-week detoxification, followed by an individualised rehabilitation lasting for 12 to 26 weeks, whereas the treatment programme for psychotropic substance abusers lasts for 26 to 52 weeks. All residents are to be assessed monthly to monitor their treatment progress and to prepare for their reintegration into the community. In the past year, SKC has admitted a total of 592 persons.

SKC provides comprehensive psycho-social skills training for residents, as well as relapse prevention and prevention of infecting HIV/AIDS. To enhance the employability of the residents, SKC has conducted several vocational training courses in the past year including Painting & Decoration Course, Plumbing and Pipe-fitting Course funded by the Beat Drugs Fund, a Foundation Certificate in Chef Assistant Training Course sponsored by the Employees Retraining Board and an Elementary Computer Course subsidised by Adult Education Subvention Scheme by Labour and Welfare Bureau. Upon completion of the courses, they can obtain certificates from relevant authorities. Other job skills training ranging from woodwork, metal work, masonry, aquaponic farming, gardening, painting to in-house repair and maintenance are also provided. SKC has offered a range of specialised courses aimed at aiding non-Chinese residents' integration into the local community including Chinese language classes, music lessons, magic workshops, and coffee brewing classes.

在品格培養方面,院方提供不同的動物寄養和護理活動,培養院友的關懷和責任感,並安排抗區義工服務。為進一步加強院友為工服務,為進一步加強院方自2012年開始推行一項名為「同經濟學」,院方自2012年開始在過程,一項各人,院方亦設立一個設備不同。同時,院方亦完成修葺因2018年海會型。同時,院方亦完成修葺因2018年將內海堤道路及康復社,來年將會別經濟等。

院方同時提供多個興趣小組,例如足球、健身班、乒乓球、羽毛球和樂隊等,以加強院友的身心發展。不同的宗教團體會定期到本院提供宗教服務,以滿足院友心靈和信仰上的需要。於春節、中秋節和聖誕節期間,院方會為院友籌辦慶祝聚會。院方非常鼓勵家屬及外間志願團體探訪院友,以幫助他們建立家庭關係和社區支援。為了確保院友在重新融入社區後脫離毒品,所有院友離院後會由本會註冊社工跟進,並提供為期12個月的專業善後輔導。

此外,院方亦致力推廣禁毒預防教育,接待相關團 體到訪,社工更定期帶領康復員到學校作禁毒宣傳 教育。 For character development, SKC provides various animal care and fostering activities for residents to promote their sense of caring and responsibility. Besides, they will be arranged to participate in volunteer services to the community. To further strengthen their determination to stay away from drugs, a long-distance running programme, namely "Run for a Mission" has been started since 2012 to let residents participate in various competitions and charity runs in the community. SKC also set up a well-equipped fitness room to encourage residents to build self-confidence and social responsibility through exercise. At the same time, SKC has completed the repair of the seawall road and the rehabilitation centre that were damaged by the strong typhoon Mangkhut in 2018. In the coming year, several adventure-based counselling courses will be launched, including a variety of water activities and mindfulness training.

Various hobby and interest groups like football, fitness training, table tennis, badminton and music band are arranged to enhance their athletic and cultural development. Religious services are also provided by different religious bodies to cater for their spiritual and religious needs. In addition, festival gatherings during Chinese New Year, Mid-Autumn and Christmas are organised for the residents. Visits by family members and other volunteers are encouraged to strengthen their family ties and social support. To ensure a drug-free life after their reintegration into the community, a 12-month professional aftercare service is provided by registered social workers for all residents after they leave SKC.

In addition, SKC has fully committed to promoting anti-drug prevention education, receiving visits from relevant groups to visit SKC. Our social workers also accompany rehabilitants to schools for anti-drug publicity and education.

凹頭青少年中心成立於1997年,主要為29歲或以下濫藥青少 年,提供自願住院戒毒康復服務。除自行申請入住中心外,也 有感化主任或濫用精神藥物者輔導中心社工轉介,接受整個治 療程序包括一至三星期的斷癮治療,及一般三至十二個月的康 復療程。

由2002年7月開始,凹頭青少年中心採用「治療社區」模式, 強調個人責任、紀律和服從,透過晉升制度培養奮鬥自強和助 己助人的精神,並藉著互助互愛的團體生活,促進個人成長。 受到疫情影響期間,中心的課堂也以視像的形式進行,但也 影響不到學員們的學習進度,當中一位學員報考國際普通中學 教育文憑數學科考試並取得193/200的成績,另一位學員報考 香港中學文憑考試並成功報讀高級文憑社工課程;此外・十二 位學員完成獨木舟一、二及三星章證書課程、八名學員完成C 級寵物美容證書課程、十位學員完成山藝一級證書課程及一位 學員考取咖啡沖調師證書資格。同時,為強化家屬和學員的溝 通,中心定期組織家屬小組和家長日活動。

為確保他們能夠保持操守及接受適當的支援和轉介服務,學員離院 後會接受一年的善後輔導。去年,該中心共接納了28名學員入住。

Au Tau Youth Centre (ATYC) became operational in 1997 and mainly provides voluntary residential treatment and rehabilitation to young male drug abusers of or under the age of 29. Apart from self-applications, referrals to the Centre are made by probation officers and social workers of Counselling Centres for Psychotropic Substance Abusers. The treatment programme includes a 1 to 3 weeks detoxification followed by an individualised period of rehabilitation ranging from 3 to 12 months under normal circumstances.

ATYC has adopted the Therapeutic Community (TC) model since July 2002. The TC model provides opportunity for the trainees to learn responsibility, discipline and conformity. Through planned work and a hierarchy position system, trainees learn responsibility, diligence and mutual help. The ultimate goal is to achieve personal growth through mutual aid and communal life. In response to the pandemic of COVID-19, online teaching had been adopted in our Centre. As a result, 1 trainee attended The International General Certificate of Secondary Education Mathematics examination with 193/200 marks, 1 trainee registered HKDSE and enrolled Higher Diploma of Social Work successfully. Besides, 12 trainees finished Kayak 1, 2 & 3 Star Award Training, 8 trainees passed the "Dog & Cat Grooming Qualification Examination as Grade C Professional Canine Cosmetologists", 10 trainees finished Level 1 Mountain Certificate Course and 1 trainee successfully acquired and internationally recognised "City and Guilds Professional Barista Certificate". Moreover, the Centre regularly runs family support groups and family days to foster the families' communication with the trainees.

Trainees on discharge from the Centre are offered 1-year aftercare to ensure their abstinence and to provide them with the necessary support or referrals. Last year, 28 trainees went through the programme.

Sister Aguinas Memorial Women's Treatment Centre

區貴雅修女紀念婦女康復中心於1968年開始提供服務,為濫藥女性(特別是年輕濫藥女性)提供三至十二個 月的自願住院戒毒治療及康復服務。

除了由1982年開始採用「治療社區」模式外,在康復程序上也結合社會心理輔導。為了針對年輕濫藥女性的需要,程序上強調正面的群體支持及朋輩影響;而且也著重提高學員的自我認識、責任感、情緒處理及解決問題能力。配合香港中學文憑試的課程,區貴雅修女紀念婦女康復中心在教育課程內容上也包括通識、科技與生活及視覺藝術等科目,讓學員們有多元的學習機會。

受疫情影響·區貴雅修女紀念婦女康復中心以網上課程提供不同的職業技能訓練·包括「寵物美容證書課程」、「專業西式甜品證書課程」、「創意手工藝製作課程」、「咖啡拉花證書課程」、「基礎英語會話課程」及「職前工作坊」等·讓學員裝備自己·以便更順利重投社會。

區貴雅修女紀念婦女康復中心讓學員接觸新興的運動、音樂及團隊訓練項目,讓學員們保持身心健康, 遠離毒品。

去年·區貴雅修女紀念婦女康復中心共接納了76名學員入住。

The Sister Aquinas Memorial Women's Treatment Centre (WTC) commenced its service in 1968. It provides 3 to 12 months of voluntary drug treatment and rehabilitation to female drug abusers, especially young female drug abusers.

Apart from adopting the Therapeutic Community (TC) model since 1982, the Centre also incorporates psycho-social counselling into its rehabilitation programme. To address the specific needs of young female drug abusers, emphasis is put on positive group and peer support. Moreover, the rehabilitation programme focuses on enhancing the trainees' self-understanding, sense of responsibility, emotion management, and problem-solving skills. To tie in with the curriculum of the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination, WTC includes liberal studies, technology, and living and visual art, etc. in the educational programmes and at the same time provides diversified learning opportunities for the trainees.

Due to the pandemic, various job skill training courses are held online for the trainees, such as "Pet Grooming Certificate Course", "Professional Western Dessert Certificate Course", "Creative Handmade Art and Craft Course", "Coffee Latte Art Certificate Course", "Basic English Oral Class" and "Pre-vocational Workshop", etc, to equip themselves to re-integrate into the society smoothly.

New sports, music, and team-building activities were also introduced to trainees to keep them physically and mentally healthy and stay away from drugs.

Last year, 76 trainees were admitted into the Centre.

成年婦女康復中心

Adult Female Rehabilitation Centre

成年婦女康復中心成立於1997年,為30歲或以上的 成年濫藥婦女提供三至十二個月的自願性住院式康 復治療。中心也會為有志戒除毒癮的女性提供短期 住院斷癮治療。此外,中心亦會安排住院婦女和兒 童進行家庭探訪及親子活動。

入住中心的婦女大部份均有長期使用毒品的歷 史,兼有複雜的情緒、個人及家庭困難。為了照 顧她們特別的需要,中心提供個人及家庭輔導、 小組治療、生活技能訓練、親職技巧訓練及家庭 生活教育等。

中心也舉辦了多元化的訓練課程,以裝備婦女們將 來能成功回歸家庭及工作崗位。課程包括:情緒調 適小組、靜觀訓練、自我挑戰訓練、藝術繪畫創 作、義工服務、拉伸及瑜伽班、縫紉班、電腦班及 烹飪班等。中心亦與不同的機構合作,舉行特別活 動,包括:禁毒基金「正念學堂」優化女性治療康 復及續顧計劃、懲教署體育會慈善基金資助計劃之 「展康健康體訓練計劃」及「安迪潘瑜伽聯盟」的 瑜伽訓練等。

成年婦女康復中心去年共接納了19位婦女接受康復治 療,亦轉介了34位婦女到區貴雅修女紀念婦女康復中 心進行斷癮戒毒治療,並為她們提供續顧服務。

The Adult Female Rehabilitation Centre (AFRC) was established in 1997. It provides 3 to 12 months of voluntary residential treatment and rehabilitation service to adult female drug users of or above the age of 30. The Centre also offers a short-term detoxification programme to women who are desirous of completing detoxification in a residential setting. The Centre also arranges family visits and parent-child activities for female residents.

Most of our female residents have a long drug use history with complex emotional, personal, and family difficulties. To cater to their special needs, the Centre provides individual and family counselling, therapeutic groups, life skills training, parenting skills training, and family life education.

Providing a variety of training courses to women, our residents were well-equipped to return to family and work in the future. Courses include Emotion Adjustment Training, Mindfulness Training, Selfchallenge Training, Art Creation work, Volunteer Service, Stretching and Yoga, Sewing Class, Computer Class, and Cooking Class. The Centre also cooperates with different organisations to hold special programmes, including Beat Drugs Fund "Mindfulness Training", Correctional Services Department Sports Association Charity Fund Subsidy Scheme "Healthy Fitness Training Programme", and Andiappan Yoga Community "Yoga Training".

Last year, a total of 19 adult females were admitted into the Centre for rehabilitation treatment. The Centre also provided counselling services to 34 adult females who had undergone detoxification treatment at Sister Aquinas Memorial Women's Treatment Centre. Hence, aftercare service was also provided.

美沙酮治療計劃輔導服務

Methadone Treatment Programme Counselling Service

香港戒毒會自1993年與衞生署合作,為美沙酮服藥人士提供輔導服務。凡年齡在21歲以下的青少年吸毒者、初次申請美沙酮治療的人士和女性吸毒者,均會優先接受服務。其他服藥人士則可以透過自行申請、經醫生轉介或經本會社工的邀請而獲得輔導服務。截至2023年3月底,共有1,907位美沙酮服藥人士接受本會的輔導服務,其中參與脫癮療程人士為167人,接受為期18個月的善後輔導跟進服務的成功脫癮人士為30人。去年,本會社工為美沙酮個案進行了15,960次面談和822次探訪、提供了1,925次對外轉介服務。

SARDA had joined hands with the Department of Health to provide counselling service for methadone patients since 1993. Methadone patients under the age of 21, first-time applicants and female patients are given priority to receive the counselling service. Other patients may also enjoy the service through self-application, referral by doctors or invitation by SARDA social workers. As at 31 March 2023, a total of 1,907 methadone patients received counselling services. Among them, 167 patients were under the detoxification programme and 30 patients received the 18-month post-detoxification aftercare service. Last year, our social workers conducted 15,960 interviews and 822 visits for methadone patients. 1,925 referrals were made to external services.



家暉舍戶外活動 Family Association Outing

本會自2002年10月開始積極推行一系列小組服 務,包括輔導小組、婦女組、青年組、家屬組、 功課輔導班、康樂活動及社區義工服務。輔導小 組推動組員互相分享及學習如何處理生活上的壓 力及困難。婦女組關注女性服藥人士獨特的需 要,如怎樣照料子女及婦女生理衞生等。青年組 透過領袖訓練及人際關係技巧訓練等活動,協助 組員建立自尊、自我形象和自信心。家屬組鼓勵 組員自助及互助, 並學習了解美沙酮服藥人士的 一些重吸先兆行為。本會於2004年3月協助美 沙酮服藥人士家屬成立「家暉舍」自助組織・ 至今已有超過1,000名登記會員。我們舉辦康樂 活動以協助服藥人士建立新的生活模式、驅除空 虚與寂寞、減輕生活壓力、增加生活情趣以及降 低對 毒品的渴求。我們組織社區義工服務,讓美 沙酮服藥人士透過助人的過程,獲得正面的自我 評價,從而成功重返社會。去年,我們舉辦了 646節小組,共有4,661位美沙酮服藥人士/家 屬參與。

Since October 2002, a series of group services for methadone patients had been launched, including counselling groups for patients of all ages, female groups, youth groups, family groups, tutorial classes, recreational activities and community volunteer services. The counselling groups focus on sharing and coping strategies. The female groups focus on genderspecific needs of female patients such as child-caring, women's health, etc. The youth groups aim at enhancing members' self-esteem, selfimage and self-confidence through leadership and interpersonal skills training. The family groups encourage family members to support each other in the recovery process. The family members can also learn about relapse cues and warnings in the client which may indicate an impending return to drug abuse. The Family Association of the Methadone Treatment Programme (MTP) patients was set up in March 2004, with over 1,000 registered members. Social and recreational activities are also held to help methadone patients develop new lifestyles. Healthy activities reduce boredom and loneliness, help manage stress, provide opportunities for fun and reduce drug cravings. Community volunteer services are organised to help methadone patients develop positive self-regard through helping other people. All these can contribute to the patient's success in social reintegration. During the reporting year, a total of 646 group sessions were conducted with 4,661 participants.

本會透過四間社會服務中心提供入院登記、善後輔導 服務、社區教育及康樂活動予戒毒及康復人士。中心 特別著重為康復人士提供善後輔導、職業輔導及有益 身心的文娛康樂活動,以協助他們遠離毒品,並維持 操守。

去年,共有900人透過本會四間社會服務中心進行入 院前登記接受康復治療。此外,本會社工為輔導個案 進行了12,463次個人面談、443次家庭輔導及270次 探訪,並舉辦了1,378次小組活動,共有11,583名個案 參與。

此外,為方便自願戒毒人士,本會推行流動外展登記 服務,在市區及新界選定的美沙酮診所、公園及避寒 中心提供直接登記及辦理入院手續。

The 4 Social Service Centres provide admission registration, aftercare service, community education and recreational activities to patients and drug rehabilitants. The Centres place special emphasis on aftercare counselling, employment guidance, as well as social and recreational activities to help the drug rehabilitants maintain a drugfree life.

During the reporting year, a total of 900 drug abusers were registered for treatment and rehabilitation at the 4 Social Service Centres. Our social workers conducted 12.463 interviews, 443 family interviews and 270 visits. A total of 1,378 group sessions were conducted with 11,583 participants.

SARDA also provides outreach registration and intake service in selected methadone clinics, public parks and cold shelters.

中途宿舍

Halfway Houses

本會設立中途宿舍的目的是為戒毒康復人士提供重 返社會前的短期居所,透過社工及宿舍職員的輔導 和支持、協助康復人士重建家庭關係及社交網絡、 進一步加強他們的解難能力及預防重吸技巧,以鞏 固他們重返社會後過無毒生活的決心和能力; 更鼓 勵舍員參加本會社會服務中心舉辦的文娛康樂活動 以及報讀各種職業技能訓練課程,重新建立健康的 生活模式並準備重投社會工作,成為社會上具生產 力的一員。

本會共設有五間中途宿舍,包括一間以自負盈虧模式 運作的自助宿舍 - 白普理培青中心。本會為男性戒毒 康復人士提供的宿位共 64 個,而為女性戒毒康復人 士提供的宿位則為 12 個。去年,共有 125 位康復人 士入住宿舍,全年平均使用率為82.0%。

The setup of halfway houses is to provide shortterm accommodation for drug rehabilitated persons during the stage of social reintegration. Through counselling and support by social workers and the staff at halfway houses, rehabilitants can rebuild family relationships and social networks, as well as increase their problem-solving and relapse-prevention skills. Residents are encouraged to participate in recreational activities organised by social service centres to re-develop a new and healthy living style and to enroll in job skills training courses so as to equip themselves to become productive members of the society.

SARDA runs a total of 5 halfway houses, including one operating on a self-financing basis - The Bradbury Pui Ching Centre. The five halfway houses provide 64-bed spaces for males and 12-bed spaces for females. Last year, a total of 125 drug rehabilitated persons were admitted to the halfway houses, which recorded an average utilisation rate of 82.0%.

「無毒共融、美好社區」-

社區為本非華裔高危人士禁毒預防外展教育服務 2.0

"A Drug Free Pluralistic and Harmonious Community" – A community-based reaching out drug prevention and intervention for high-risk and hidden Non-ethnic Chinese 2.0

由2017年7月開始·香港戒壽會獲得禁壽基金贊助·設立「『無毒共融、美好社區』-社區為本少數族裔高危青年禁毒預防外展服務」。承蒙禁毒基金支持·本會續獲贊助延續非華裔外展服務·自2020年8月起·將受惠對象擴展至不同年齡層及提供多元化服務給有需要的非華裔人士·提升他們正視濫用藥物對身心的影響。

本計劃服務對象為非華裔人士。本隊以外展方式到不同地方接觸高危人士·提供預防吸毒/戒毒輔導及服務·並新增醫療服務津貼(適用於各醫療服務·包括牙科·精神科及婦科等)·提升吸毒人士對自身健康的關注及了解吸毒行為對身體的影響;舉辦不同興趣班及職業培訓課程·讓參加者建立正面興趣。

除了鼓勵吸毒人士關注自己的健康和需要,提升他們戒毒的動機外,亦善用地區資源和建立地區網絡,與不同非華裔地區團體、社福機構、學校合作舉辦預防濫用藥物的教育工作坊,分享本會就非華裔人士所提供的全方位外展教育及輔導、住院、續顧服務,以便大眾更了解本會服務和接觸有需要人士。另外,本隊亦招募非華裔康復人士為實習生,協助本隊服務及向公眾人士分享自己康復經驗。

過去六年,外展隊接觸非華裔人士達8,009人次;為高危人士、吸毒人士及協助受毒品困擾的人士和其家長提供輔導服務和轉介,讓更多非華裔人士得悉本會服務和正視濫用藥物情況,以達至「無毒共融、美好社區」的願景。

A team for non-Chinese, "A Drug Free Pluralistic and Harmonious Community – A community-based reaching out drug prevention and intervention for high-risk and hidden non-Chinese ethnic youth", was started in July 2017 with sponsorship from the Beat Drugs Fund. We are glad that the Beat Drugs Fund keeps supporting the service for non-ethnic Chinese and the project "A Drug Free Pluralistic and Harmonious Community – A community-based reaching out drug prevention and intervention for high-risk and hidden Non-ethnic Chinese 2.0" was launched in August 2020. The service targets were extended to all ages of non-ethnic Chinese and various services were provided in order to raise public awareness of both physical and psychological harms caused by drug-taking behaviour under the continued support from the Beat Drugs Fund.

The team goes to different places to approach non-ethnic Chinese, promotes anti-drug messages, provides counselling services and offers prompt referral or registration of treatment services to service targets. To enhance awareness of health conditions and drug-related issues and raise the target's motivations on rebuilding a healthier life, subsidies for drug abusers to seek medical services including dentistry, psychiatry, gynaecology etc. Also, there are different interest classes and vocational training courses for service targets to build up healthy lifestyles and strengthen their interests.

Apart from raising the targets' awareness of their health and motivation for treatment needs, the team builds up networks with local groups and utilises community resources. The team co-works with non-ethnic Chinese community groups, NGOs and schools for drug prevention talks and workshops for the public and family members of drug abusers in order to let the public know more about the rounded services for non-ethnic Chinese (from outreaching service, inpatient service and aftercare service) provided by SARDA and approach the one in need. Former non-ethnic Chinese drug abusers are recruited to be interns. They work with the team and share their rehabilitation experiences with the public.

In the past six years, more than 8,009 contacts with non-ethnic Chinese have been made. The team offered prompt referrals for the high-risk groups and drug abusers and provided counselling services to them and their families so as to establish a drug free and harmonious community as the final goal.

本會在2022年8月起獲禁毒基金贊助推行為期3年的「燃希攻略 -優化康復治療及續顧服務計劃」2.0。本計劃旨在以凹頭青少年 中心康復中人士的生活模式為介入點,為他們於院舍住宿及續 顧期間提供多方面的訓練、支援及輔導服務,以改變他們的生 活模式,確保離院後可以融入社會,重燃希望,建立健康無毒

計劃主要分為三個部分,第一個部分主要圍繞康復中人士工 作、升學規劃,為康復者舉辦職業技能證書課程,使康復者找 到合適的工作、職業技能培訓課程或學校。透過小組及興趣班 訓練,加強其自我管理能力,建立正面價值觀,提升解難及建 立人際關係的技巧,協助康復中人士重返社會,建立穩定的生 活模式。第二個部分為康復中人士回饋社會。透過義工服務、 過來人分享會和禁毒音樂會,康復中人士以自身經歷向公眾人 士宣傳禁毒訊息,正面建立他們的形象,並增加其自我效能感 及自信,提升預防復吸能力。第三部分為家人輔導。透過向家 人及康復中人士提供家庭輔導及介入,讓家人了解他們的進度 和成長,強化家人與康復中人士的關係,協助他們重建健康的 家庭牛活。

計劃開展至2023年6月30日,為35位康復中人士進行共421節 個人升學就業輔導和17位康復中人士參與職業技能證書課程; 此外,共有340次參與個人成長小組,並有938人次參與各個興 趣班訓練,與38位康復中人士家人進行共110節家人輔導,及舉 行5次過來人分享會並向613位中學生和16位大專生宣傳禁毒訊 息。另外,共有12人次參與了義工服務。

Sponsored by the Beat Drugs Fund, SARDA implemented a 3-year project named "Enlightening Hope - Strengthening Rehabilitation and Aftercare Services Programme" 2.0 starting from August 2022. The project aims at intervening with the rehabilitees in Au Tau Youth Centre and the graduates from the Centre with their lifestyle through counselling, training and support services. The project is to ensure the rehabilitees can reintegrate into society and sustain their healthy lifestyle.

The project mainly consists of three parts. The first part concerns the life planning of rehabilitees. The project aims to help to match them with job skills training courses, suitable jobs and schools. There is a wide range of hobby groups and developmental groups to enhance rehabilitees on their values, communication skills and self-control. The second part is to contribute to society with rehabilitees' personal experience. Through volunteer work, sharing and music concerts, rehabilitees share their experience in rehabilitation and share the anti-drug message. Meanwhile, they can boost their confidence and self-efficacy. The third part is family counselling. Through family counselling, the family will understand more about the rehabilitation progress change of rehabilitees so that trust and healthy relationships can be strengthened.

As at 30 June 2023, 35 rehabilitees underwent 421 sessions of counselling concerning their life planning, and 17 rehabilitees took part in vocational skills certificate training. Moreover, a total of 340 attendees participated in the developmental group. For the hobby groups, 938 attendees were joining them. Also, 38 family members of the rehabilitees joined 110 family counselling, and five sessions to promote anti-drug messages to 613 secondary students and 16 tertiary students. Furthermore, there were 12 attendees participated in volunteer services.

種族共融 2.0

Hand in Hand 2.0

本會於2022年3月成功獲民政事務總署撥款舉辦「種 族共融2.0」計劃,當中包括學習印度舞蹈、牆畫藝 術、音樂班、歷奇訓練活動和康體活動等。計劃主要 以區內非華裔和華裔戒毒康復人士和社區人士為主要 服務對象,期望透過活動提升他們的社區參與度和歸 屬感,以及提升社區人士對戒毒康復人士的了解和接 納。本計劃更邀請了非政府機構、少數族裔地區組織 等合作和參與推動。

計劃於深水埗區舉辦兩場牆畫繪畫活動,推廣種族 共融的訊息,透過與區內兩間商店(分別是一間中醫 診所以及一間巴基斯坦雜貨店)合作,讓參加者於其 店舖鐵閘上設計種族共融的畫作。不論華裔或者非 華裔人士亦反應熱烈,踴躍參加。非華裔人士如尼 泊爾裔、印度裔及巴基斯坦裔等參加者,更寫上自 己語言的祝福語。參加者除學習繪畫技巧外,更透 過畫作表達種族共融及和諧共處的訊息。本計劃亦 於石鼓洲康復院內進行了牆畫繪畫的活動,讓非華 裔與華裔戒毒院友共同合作,建構一個和諧共融、 友善關愛的康復環境。

計劃亦透過舉辦歷奇體驗活動,鼓勵華裔與非華裔人 士合作和溝通,包括運用身體語言,打破隔閡,促進 種族共融。

In March 2022, SARDA successfully received funding from the Home Affairs Department to organise the "Hand in hand 2.0" project, which includes learning Indian dance, wall painting art, music classes, adventure training activities, and recreational and sports activities. The project mainly targets non-Chinese and Chinese drug rehabilitants and community members. It hopes to reinforce their participation in community affairs and sense of belonging, as well as enhance understanding and acceptance of drug rehabilitants by the community. This project also invites non-governmental organisations, and organisations that serve local ethnic minority groups to cooperate and participate in promotion.

The project organised two wall painting activities in Sham Shui Po District to promote the message of racial inclusion. Through cooperation with two shops in the district (a Chinese medicine clinic and a Pakistani grocery store), participants were invited to create paintings of racial inclusion on the iron gates. Both Chinese and non-Chinese members of the community participated enthusiastically. Non-Chinese participants, such as Nepalese, Indian and Pakistani, were so passionate that they wrote blessings in their own languages. In addition to learning painting skills, participants also expressed the message of racial inclusion and living in harmony through paintings. This project also carried out wall painting activities in the Shek Kwu Chau Treatment and Rehabilitation Centre (SKC), allowing non-Chinese and Chinese residents to work together to build a harmonious, inclusive, friendly and caring rehabilitation environment.

By organising adventure experience activities, the project encourages cooperation and communication between Chinese and non-Chinese people, including the use of body language to break down barriers and promote racial inclusion.

同創未來計劃學習教室

Hand-in-hand Children Learning Station

本會在滙豐香港社區夥伴計劃贊助下,於2022年9 月至2023年8月推行「同創未來計劃學習教室」。 這項計劃的目的是協助美沙酮服藥人士子女改善學 習表現、規劃個人發展、投入音樂活動改善情緒控 制、促進他們身心健康、學習興趣、提升自信及計 劃未來。

去年,這項計劃為121位參加者舉辦了35節功課輔導班、35節音樂訓練小組、2節一對一的個人導師服務、3節職業分享會、2次探訪長者中心及安老院義工服務、1次正念親子活動及32節英語工作坊。訓練評估顯示,100%兒童報告他們在自我效能感、學習動機和興趣、個人技能、社會歸屬感及抗逆力方面有改善。整體來說,這項計劃能夠幫助吸毒人士子女建立自信和計劃未來,這兩方面是兒童成長和發展的關鍵要素。

With support from HSBC Hong Kong Community Partnership Programme, SARDA implemented a project named "Hand-in-hand Children Learning Station" from September 2022 to August 2023. The Project aimed at helping children of methadone patients for enhancing their academic performance, personal growth, interest in musical activities for better emotional regulation, physical wellness, learning interest, enhancing self-confidence and career planning.

Last year, the project conducted 35 tutorial class sessions, 35 musical sessions, 2 sessions with one-to-one mentorship service, 3 career training sessions, 2 elderly volunteer services, 1 mindfulness training session as well as 32 English language workshops for 121 participants in total. Post-training evaluation indicated that 100% of the children reported improvements in their self-efficacy, learning motivation and interest, skill competence, social belonging and resiliency. Overall, the Project helped the children of drug-using parents to build confidence and plan for their future, which are key features of child growth and development.

健康家庭親子樂計劃 2.0

Happy and Healthy Family Scheme 2.0

本會於2020年8月在禁毒基金贊助下推行一項為期 三年的「健康家庭親子樂計劃2.0」。這項計劃的 目的是協助目前或曾經受毒品影響的家長提升抗毒 能力和親職效能感。

本計劃分為四個部份:「脫獨計劃」為子女大多數留在院舍或寄養家庭的吸毒家長提供之工工的。「勵進計劃」為為子社工面說 職困難的戒毒康復家長提供社工評估,為職別練及親子活動。「專業訓練」為從事戒人,,我康復受 毒品影響家庭的能力。以及,「義工小隊」,把們 最定康復家長,提供訓練及服務機會,提升他們自我信心及抗毒能力。

去年·這項計劃為73位家長提供了898節個人及小組親職訓練。

With support from the Beat Drugs Fund, SARDA implemented a 3-year project named "Happy and Healthy Family Scheme 2.0" starting from August 2020. The Project aims to help those parents who are currently or formerly affected by drug abuse to improve their drug refusal ability and parenting capacity.

The Project consists of four parts. Reunion Programme provides social work assessment, parenting capacity training and family activities for drug using parents whose children are mostly receiving foster care services. Recovery Programme provides social work assessment, parenting capacity training and family activities for drug rehabilitee parents with difficulties in parenting their children. Professional Training and Sharing Session provides training to social workers in the field of drug abuse and family service, with an aim to enhance their self-efficacy in serving drug-affected families. Lastly, volunteer team recruits and trains drug rehabilitee parents to serve others to enhance their self-efficacy and ability of drug refusal.

Last year, the Project provided 898 sessions of individual and group parenting skills training sessions for 73 parents.

靈靜假期 2.0 - 短期住宿治療計劃

Mindful Break 2.0 – Short Term Treatment Programme

本會在2022年8月起獲禁毒基金贊助推行為期3年的 「靈靜假期2.0 - 短期住宿治療計劃」。本計劃為 40歲或以下有吸毒習慣之男性或女性,提供14天 短期住宿計劃,旨在暫時脫離毒品並整理思路, 為重返社區接受戒毒服務或繼續接受院舍治療作 準備。

本計劃加強發揮短期住宿的優勢,以吸引更多低 動機人士去戒毒,同時為高動機戒毒者發展密集 而有系統的14日戒毒輔導模式。另一方面本計劃 進行線下抗毒宣傳活動,更加入線上抗毒宣傳去 接觸隱蔽吸毒者。務求為隱蔽吸毒者、低及高動 機戒毒者服務。

計劃開展至2023年3月31日,已為40名吸毒者提供 初期評估及輔導服務,當中32位願意接受14日密集 而有系統的短期戒毒住宿療程,包括:專業輔導、 24小時醫護照顧、興趣活動和健體訓練,亦為31 位吸毒者家人提供70節家人輔導。在公眾抗毒教育 上,本計劃在線下活動接觸了210人,並在社交媒 體線上接觸1,874人。超過72.7%的吸毒者於參與計 劃後提升戒毒動機、提升拒絕毒品的自我效能感、 減少吸毒頻次,72.7%的吸毒者家人於參與計劃後 提升對吸毒者的支援能力,70%公眾於禁毒宣傳活 動中提升抗毒意識。

In August 2022, SARDA received funding from the Beat Drugs Fund to implement the three-year "Mindful Break 2.0 - Short Term Treatment Programme", which provides a 14-day short-term residential programme for male or female drug abusers aged 40 or below. It aims to offer drug abusers a break from drugs so that they can reorganise their thoughts and get prepared to return to the community by receiving drug treatment services or continuing the residential treatment programme.

With the advantages of short-term residence, this Programme attracts more people with low motivation to detoxify to participate; it also develops an intensive and systematic 14-day detoxification counselling model for those with high motivation. Besides, the Programme carries out offline anti-drug activities as well as online anti-drug publicity to reach out to hidden drug addicts. It strives to serve hidden drug addicts, low and high motivation drug abusers.

From the Programme being launched to 31 March, 2023, we have provided initial assessment and counselling services to 40 drug addicts. 32 of them are willing to receive a 14-day intensive and systematic short-term residential drug rehabilitation treatment, including: professional counselling, 24-hour medical care, interest activities and fitness training. The Programme also provided 70 counselling sessions to 31 family members of drug abusers. In terms of antidrug education to members of the public, this Programme contacted 210 people through offline activities and 1,874 people through social media. More than 72.7% of drug abusers have enhanced their motivation to guit drugs, improved their self-efficacy to refuse drugs, and reduced the frequency of drug abuse after participating in the Programme. 72.7% of drug abusers' family members have improved their ability to support drug abusers after participating in the Programme. 70% of the public have improved their antidrug awareness after participating in anti-drug activities.

職業技能課程 Vocational Skills Training

於2021年8月起,本會獲禁毒基金贊助推行爲期三年的「正念學堂」優化女性治療康復及續顧計劃。本計劃為受毒品問題困擾的婦女提供多元化訓練課程及預防重吸輔導服務,協助婦女提升自我覺察力,鼓勵自我關懷,並促進個人成長。

計劃分爲四個重點:(一)婦女身心靈健康活動,包括正念成長課程、預防重吸輔導、健康講座及瑜伽工作坊;(二)家庭活動:包括親職輔導、家人輔導及生活技能訓練,以協助婦女重建家庭關係;(三)職業技能訓練,包括職前工作坊、職業技能培訓課程及續顧服務,以裝備婦女重投社會;(四)禁毒預防教育,包括於中學作過來人分享及社區義工服務,以宣傳禁毒訊息。

截至2023年3月31日,本計劃共為88位婦女及79位家人提供服務,共舉辦了169節正念成長小組、377次預防重吸輔導,85節親職輔導、208次家人輔導、5項職業技能培訓證書課程及5項社區義工服務及2次過來人分享會。

Starting from August 2021, the Society has been sponsored by the Beat Drugs Fund to implement a 3-year project called "Mindfulness Training: Women-Focused Rehabilitation & After-care Project". The project provides different training and relapse prevention to women who are suffering from drug problems. The Project enhances women's self-awareness, self-care, and personal growth.

The Project is divided into four important areas: (1) Women's mind, body and health programmes, including mindfulness training, relapse prevention counselling, health talks and yoga workshops; (2) Family activities for helping women to rebuild the family relationship, including parenting training, family counselling and life skills training; (3) Vocational training for equipping women to reintegrate into society, including job hunting workshops, vocational skills training courses and after-care services; (4) Anti-drug prevention such as school talks and community volunteer services for promoting anti-drug publicity.

As of 31 March 2023, the Project has provided services for 88 women and 79 family members. A total of 169 sessions of mindfulness growth groups, 377 sessions of relapse prevention counselling, 85 sessions of parenting sessions, 208 sessions of family counselling sessions, 5 sessions of vocational skills training course, 5 community volunteer services and 2 school talks have been conducted.

鳳凰計劃

Phoenix Project

本會於2000年在衞生署紅絲帶中心資助下推行「鳳 凰計劃」。這項計劃招募一群成功戒毒個案及數位 尼泊爾美沙酮服藥人士,以外展方式向流連街頭的 吸毒者提供愛滋病預防教育。這項計劃在2003年開 始獲得愛滋病信託基金的贊助。

「鳳凰計劃」的目的是提高流連街頭的吸毒者對感染愛 滋病病毒風險的警覺,並鼓勵他們減少共用針筒、在進 行性行為時使用安全套及接受愛滋病病毒抗體測試。

去年,「鳳凰計劃」共展開了310次活動,接觸吸 毒者達8,151人次,其中包括3,050名新來港人士及 少數族裔人士。此外,計劃亦分別為本地吸毒者及 少數族裔吸毒者舉行27次小組,分別有216人次及 287人次出席,地點為油麻地、深水埗、屯門、元 朗、貝夫人等美沙酮診所,同時亦為20位吸毒人士 提供82節輔導服務。

這項計劃透過每年進行吸毒者街頭訪問評估其 成效。最近一次訪問在2022年7月進行,抽樣訪 問了684位吸毒者。訪問結果顯示94.4%的被訪 者曾經接受愛滋病病毒測試並知悉測試結果, 82.6%的被訪者在最近一次進行性行為時使用安 全套,97.1%的被訪者在最近一次吸毒時沒有與 陌牛人共用針筒。

SARDA started the Phoenix Project in 2000 with financial support from the Red Ribbon Centre of the Department of Health. The Project recruited a group of former drug users and several Nepalese methadone patients as peer volunteers to provide outreaching HIV preventive education to street drug users. The Project has been sponsored by The AIDS Trust Fund since 2003.

The Project aims at increasing street drug users' awareness on HIV/AIDS, encouraging them to reduce needle sharing, to use a condom during sexual intercourse and to attend HIV antibody testing.

Last year, a total of 310 outreaching sessions were conducted with 8,151 contacts made with street drug users, in which 3,050 were new immigrants and ethnic minorities. The Project also held 27 group sessions for local drug users and ethnic minority drug users, with 216 and 287 attendances respectively. The locations were methadone clinics such as Yau Ma Tei, Sham Shui Po, Tuen Mun, Yuen Long, and Violet Peel. Moreover, the Project provided 82 sessions of counselling services to 20 drug users.

The Project outcome is evaluated by an annual survey of street-recruited drug users. The latest survey was conducted in July 2022 with a sample of 684 drug users. The findings revealed that 94.4% of the respondents attended a HIV test and knew the result, 82.6% used condom in their last sexual intercourse and 97.1% did not share needles with those outside their usual network in their last injection.


本會於2021年8月起展開了「『重整生活·更好明天』為戒毒康復人士提供住院及續顧支援2.0」計劃。計劃為期三年·目標是為石鼓洲康復院的戒毒康復人士提供各方面的支援及訓練·期望讓康復人士遠離毒品·融入社會·以及學習種族共融。此計劃可以分為兩部分·第一部份主要是關顧正接受住院式戒毒服務的非華裔戒毒康復人士·協助他們適應院舍生活;第二部份是為所有華裔及非華裔康復人士加強續顧支援·以協助他們重整生活。除了個人輔導服務外·本計劃亦提供興趣班、職業訓練課程、戶外康樂活動及義工活動·通過正面經驗建立對毒品的操守。

直至2023年,共舉行了23次非華裔支援小組、83次多元文化樂隊小組、6次音樂表演、9個職業訓練課程、12個興趣小組、10次戶外活動、14節義工活動、39節語言小組、以及個別和小組輔導服務及醫療轉介服務,共為超過2,847人次提供服務。

SARDA started a 3-year project named "'Re-structuring Life · A Better Tomorrow' - Strengthening Inpatient and Aftercare Support for Drug Rehabilitees 2.0" in August 2021. The project aims at providing aftercare services for rehabilitees discharged from Shek Kwu Chau Treatment and Rehabilitation Centre (SKC) from August 2021 to July 2024. The project is a combination of two categories, in which the first part is to provide care and support services to those non-Chinese rehabilitees for better adaptation in the residential setting, while the second part is an intensive aftercare service for both local Chinese and non-Chinese rehabilitees, in order to help them reorganise their lives and promote social inclusion. Instead of individual counselling services, this project also organises various activities, including interest classes, vocational trainings, outdoors recreational programmes, together with voluntary services. We believe that through positive experiences gained in this project, it can enhance their resistance towards drug and maintain 'Drug Free' eventually.

「星火行動」是本會在愛滋病信託基金的贊助下於2006年開始推行 的計劃,目的是為感染愛滋病病毒的美沙酮服藥人士提供心理社會服 務及促進他們接受治療的動機。這項計劃設立了一個有效的監察系 統,記錄受感染個案的資料,以助社工回應他們的服務需要,增加他 們接受愛滋病及戒毒治療的依從性。

截至2023年3月31日,「星火行動」服務了102位感染愛滋病病毒的 美沙酮服藥人士,並成功轉介了83.3%的確診個案到衞生署綜合治療 中心接受治療。在過去一年,87%的轉介個案仍出席覆診。

去年,「星火行動」提供了104次緊急現金援助,協助感染愛滋病病 毒的美沙酮服藥人士應付突發的財政困難,為他們組織了40次社交 活動,向他們派發了177份健康教育資料套。

此外,「星火行動」於去年舉辦了7次教育講座,為91位正接受院舍 戒毒治療服務或美沙酮治療計劃人士,提供預防愛滋病的正確知識。

SARDA started the Spark Action Project in 2006 with sponsorship from the AIDS Trust Fund, aiming to provide psycho-social services to HIV-infected methadone patients and to strengthen their motivation for seeking treatment. The Project sets up an effective monitoring system to keep track of methadone patients who have contracted HIV, which allows social workers to address patients' treatment needs and exhort them to adhere to medical and drug treatments.

As at 31 March 2023, Spark Action had served 102 HIVinfected methadone patients and successfully referred 83.3% of all the identified cases to the Integrated Treatment Centre of the Department of Health for further medical treatment on HIV/ AIDS. 87% of the referred cases continued to attend medical appointments in the past year.

Last year, the Project provided 104 cases of emergency financial support to cash-strapped patients in coping with unexpected financial difficulties, organised 40 social activities for HIV-infected patients and distributed 177 sets of health education kits to them.

Moreover, Spark Action had organised 7 educational workshops for 91 participants who were receiving residential drug treatment service or methadone treatment programme so as to provide them the knowledge on HIV prevention last year.

"Special Care for the Special Mothers" 3.0

承蒙禁毒基金支持·本會自2016年開始推行的「『非常照顧·非常媽媽』-懷孕女性住院戒毒康復計劃」後·於2022年2月也完成第二期資助·並從2022年7月起·開展「『非常照顧非常媽媽』3.0」計劃·服務對象為育有嬰幼兒的濫藥女性。

計劃目的為正在懷孕或育有嬰幼兒的濫藥女性·提供跨專業合作的戒毒服務·照顧她們的身心健康及胎兒的成長;服務內容包括24小時醫療照顧、臨床心理學家及社工提供個人及小組輔導服務、陪月員提供產前產後陪診及身體調理服務·計劃亦有為家人提供支援·以協助他們準備迎接及照顧新生命。本會期望透過此項計劃·能填補濫藥懷孕女性在住院戒毒服務上的需求·並協助這班準媽媽及新任媽媽重過無毒生活、作稱職的母親·並藉此預防跨代吸毒。

至2023年3月31日·「『非常照顧非常媽媽』3.0」計劃共為3位懷孕濫藥女性及10位育有嬰幼兒的濫藥女性提供服務。

With sponsorship from the Beat Drugs Fund, SARDA started the project "'Special Care for the Special Mothers' – Residential Detoxification and Rehabilitation Project for Pregnant Women" in 2016 and the second phase of Project 2.0 was also completed in February 2022. We have launched Project 3.0 in July 2022, and our service targets are extended to the drug abusing women with infants and preschoolers.

The Project aims at providing drug treatment and rehabilitation services to pregnant drug abusers and drug abusing women with infants with multi-disciplinary collaboration. Services included 24-hour medical care, individual and group counselling services provided by clinical psychologist and social worker, escort service and care by postnatal care worker, etc. as to address the physical, psychological, and social needs of the pregnant women; and take care of the development of fetus. The Project also provided support to their family members, to prepare them for the role change in taking care of the newborn. It is expected that the Project could fill the service gap in residential drug treatment for pregnant drug abusers, to help them live a drug-free life, be capable parents, and prevent cross-generational drug abuse.

Until 31 March 2023, Project 3.0 has served 3 pregnant drug women and 10 drug abusing mothers with infants/preschoolers in total.

本會自2020年8月起獲禁毒基金贊助推行為「體藝同樂助康復」計 劃,此計劃2022年9月完成。其後在2022年10月起舉行2.0計劃, 為期三年。計劃目的是以運動及藝術課程協助區貴雅修女紀念婦女 康復中心學員提升心理及生理健康,建立健康生活模式,從而鞏固 她們出院後之無毒生活。

計劃1.0主要分為兩部份,第一部份主要為學員組織不同及新興的健 體運動。第二部份是成長小組及家人分享活動,目的為鞏固學員對有 關學習進展,也可以讓學員家人了解她們成長。由2020年8月1日至 2022年9月30日,為94位學員參與此計劃課程,42位家人參與活動。

計劃2.0除舉辦不同體藝活動如:劍球、飛標、空手道、雜耍、旋 風球、豎琴、花藝及化妝造型設計等等,更加入舉辦不同證書課程 如日本酒精墨水藝術證書課程、基礎地壺教練及躲避盤教練證書課 程,讓學員日後學以致用,發揮所長。截至2023年3月31日,已為 29位學員舉辦13項體藝課程,有13位學員考獲不同證書。

With Sponsorship from Beat Drugs Fund, SARDA has started the project "'Taste of Art and Sports' - Project for the physical and mental well-being of female drug abusers under residential treatment" in August 2020. It was completed in September 2022. We have then launched the 3-year project 2.0 in October 2022. This project aims to improve the physical and mental health of rehabilitants in Sister Aquinas Memorial Women's Treatment Centre through regular art and sports activities, as well as helping them to establish a healthy lifestyle, which further consolidates their drug-free life after discharge.

Project 1.0 mainly consists of two parts. The first part consists of different kinds and newly developing Sports Programmes; the second part is to organise developmental group and family sharing activities, which further strengthen their learning with the support of their family members. From 1 August 2020 to 30 September 2022, 94 trainees joined the project, and 42 family members attended our activities.

Project 2.0 also consists of different art or sports programmes, such as Kendama, Darts, Karate, Juggling, Flyball, Harps, Floral Design, and Makeup Classes. The project also contains accreditation courses like, Alcohol Ink TUA plus one Instructor, Fundamental Floor Curling Coach and Dodgebee Instructor Courses, etc. for further development of our trainees. Till 31 March 2023, 29 trainees with 13 courses were organised and 13 trainees obtained different kinds of certificates.

「機會由你創」-全方位醫社合作外展服務 2.0

You Got Chance – multidisciplinary holistic outreaching service for drug abusers 2.0

獲禁毒基金贊助,香港戒毒會於2021年8月展開為期三年醫社外展服務2.0,由社會工作員、註冊護士及同輩輔導以醫療知識結合心理輔導模式到各公立醫院及地區,向正接受治療的濫藥人士及高危群組提供合適戒毒服務,包括醫院個案轉介、病房輔導小組、物質誤用診所外展工作及地區個案跟進等。

本隊共向10間公立醫院物質誤用診所、急症室、精神病病房、社區物質濫用外展服務及醫務社會服務等不同部門,推廣香港戒毒會全方位的戒毒治療及康復服務,並建立不同形式的合作伙伴關係。

到目前為止,此計劃透過地區及醫院外展服務,分別接觸超過1,800及500人次,當中超過120人次轉介至本會轄下住院式戒毒治療及康復中心。

Sponsored by the Beat Drugs Fund, SARDA has launched a three-year medical-social outreaching service 2.0 since August 2021 to provide suitable drug treatment services to drug abusers and high-risk groups who are receiving treatment. With their medical knowledge and psychological counselling methods, social worker, registered nurse and peer counsellor visited public hospitals and districts to reach for these people. Services rendered have included hospital case referrals, ward counselling groups, substance abuse clinic outreach and case follow-ups in community.

The team delivered full range of drug treatment and rehabilitation services of SARDA to different service units for a total of 10 public hospitals, which included substance abuse clinics, accident & emergency departments, psychiatric wards, community substance abuse outreaching service and medical social service departments. The team has thus fostered valuable networking and built-up different forms of partnership with these hospitals as well.

So far, the scheme has successfully reached for more than 1,800 people through district outreaching services and 500 through hospital networking. More than 120 of them were referred to SARDA's drug treatment and rehabilitation centres for residential drug treatment.

本會戒毒熱線自1973年投入服務,乃香港最早期 專為戒毒而設的求助熱線,服務至今超過50年。 熱線由專業註冊社工接聽,為有需要的人士及家 長提供情緒支援和疏導、吸毒問題解答及戒毒服 務轉介等。去年,共收到1,121個電話查詢。

The Drug Counselling Hotline, Hong Kong's first hotline solely targeting drug rehabilitation, has been in service for more than 50 years since it opened in 1973. The Hotline is answered by registered social workers who offer emotional support, respond inquiries on substance abuse problems, and provide drug treatment referral services for the people in need and their parents. Last year, the Hotline received a total of 1,121 calls.

本會十分重視成功戒毒康復的人士並持續聘用他 們為同輩輔導。他們作為角色模範,透過分享自 身的康復經驗而給予他人領悟和啟示;在陪伴新 出院康復人士踏上康復之路時,同輩輔導們亦能 同時加強自身持續操守的自信心。兼職的同輩輔 導主要服務美沙酮診所服藥人士,而全職的同輩 輔導則主要服務戒毒治療及康復中心的住院及離 院康復人士。去年,本會共聘用32名全職同輩輔 導及8名兼職同輩輔導。本會藉此鳴謝香港賽馬會 慈善信託基金及香港公益金大力支持本會的同輩 輔導計劃。

The Peer Counsellor Scheme continuously employs recovered patients as peer counsellors. They act as role models and through sharing their own "recovery stories", they give much insight and inspiration to others. By accompanying the "new comers" to walk on the road to recovery, the peer counsellors' self-confidence to maintain abstinence can also be enhanced. The parttime peer counsellors serve mainly at the methadone clinics, whilst the full-time peer counsellors work with the rehabilitants and those discharged from the drug treatment and rehabilitation centres. Last year, a total of 32 full-time and 8 part-time peer counsellors were employed. We take this opportunity to acknowledge The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust and The Community Chest of Hong Kong for their supports to the Scheme.

社區義工計劃

Community Volunteer Scheme

本會致力推行社區義工計劃·為了善用社區資源以及發揮互助互愛的精神·本會積極招募社會上各階層人士成為本會義工·並提供訓練。社區義工與本會康復人士共同為社區服務大大國,有對於生活。去年·共有45名社區人士登記成為本會的社區義工·共舉辦了509次戶外服務及2,803次室內活動。

The Community Volunteer Scheme was established by our Society to facilitate mutual assistance and community care. Members of the public from all walks of life are recruited. Training courses are provided to prepare them for the service. The joint effort of the community volunteers and our rehabilitated drug abusers helps to enhance the social integration, self-worthiness and self-confidence of the rehabilitants. Last year, 45 members of the public registered as community volunteers. They organised 509 outdoor services and 2,803 indoor activities.

SARDA organised anti-drug talks, ex-addicts' sharing sessions and game booth with various organisations, including schools, Parent and Teacher Associations (PTA), community organisations and other social service agencies to raise public awareness on the harmful effects of drug abuse and the importance of staying away from drugs.



SARDA maintains an outpatient clinic to carry out physical examination for applicants before admission into our drug treatment centres. It also provides medical consultation to rehabilitants.

SARDA adopted the One-step Test Strips (Urine) to verify the drug free status of both in-patients and ex-patients since April 2004. Last year, a total of 15,064 urine tests were carried out.
